



- 1945 WWII ends with Truman's decision to drop <u>A-bomb</u> on Japan
- 1954 The U<u>nited</u> N<u>ations</u> is created
- 1946 W. Churchill claimed an Iron Curtain has descended upon Europe
- 1947 *<u>Truman</u> Doctrine aid is aimed at saving <u>Greece</u> & <u>Turkey</u>
- 1948 U.S.S.R. cuts off supply route to W. Berlin and U.S. responds with an airlift
- 1948 *Marshall Plan aid will rebuild Western Europe
- 1949 U.S.S.R. detonates their first <u>A-bomb</u>

1949 – Civil War in <u>China</u> turns most populous country into a <u>Communist</u> Nation 1949 – *<u>N.A.T.O.</u> Alliance is created to offset Soviet influence in <u>E</u>. Europe



1950 – *Korean Conflict begins; as a result United Nations police action begins to defend S. Korea

1950 – (R) Sen. J. McCarthy claims communists have infested the government, starts 2nd Red Scare


1951 – <u>Rosenbergs</u> are tried and sentenced for providing nuclear secrets to the Soviets; executed <u>1953</u>

1952 – The first <u>H-Bomb</u> is detonated by U.S.






1953 – <u>Stalin</u> Dies




1953 – Korean Conflict <u>ends</u> in a <u>stalemate</u> at the <u>38th parallel</u>

1954 – *<u>S.E.A.T.O.</u> Alliance forms to protect <u>S.E. Asia</u>



1955 – Mutually Assured Destruction or <u>MAD</u> Plan introduced by John Foster Dulles

1955 – S.U. creates Warsaw Pact to offset NATO

1956 – New Soviet Premier <u>Nikita Khrushchev</u> proposes idea of "<u>peaceful coexistence</u>"




1957 – <u>Sputnik</u> launches the U.S. & Soviets into a <u>space</u> race





- 1957 *<u>Eisenhower</u> Doctrine is offered to <u>Middle East</u> countries
- 1959 Communist dictator Fidel Castro (Cuba), takes power and seizes all US assets and priv. property
- 1960 Francis Gary <u>Powers</u> is shot down in his <u>U-2</u> spy plane over U.S.S.R.









1961 – Soviets begin constructing <u>Berlin Wall</u>






1961 – <u>Bay</u> of <u>Pigs</u> invasion by 1500 CIA-trained Cuban exiles in attempt to overthrow Castro (Failure)






1962 – U.S. President JFK and Soviet Premiere Khrushchev involve world in the Cuban Missile Crisis










1969 – NASA achieves <u>moon</u> landing



1972 – Nixon recognizes <u>China</u> & visits the <u>Soviet Union</u>






1972 – First Strategic A<u>rms</u> Limitation T<u>reaty</u> (SALT)

1980 – "Miracle on Ice" occurs during Winter Olympics







1989 – <u>Tiananmen Square</u> Massacre in <u>China</u>


