Settlers of North Carolina

In the beginning, most settlers in the _____ area were tobacco farmers who had been pushed south from Virginia looking to skip paying taxes for their _____. Most were not wealthy and lived in small homes. As time went on, people began to move south, and different groups immigrated for various reasons. The town of _____ became the first permanent town (1705), followed by New Bern (1711) - about 30 miles south. _____ refugees ended up in New Bern that were fleeing from religious persecution .
